Area Information

Getting Around

You will be within walking distance of the Wrightsville Beach business district and within a five-minute drive of several other local restaurants and businesses that are still in Wrightsville Beach. On the mainland, there are three shopping centers, Lumina Commons/Lumina Station on the south side of Eastwood closest to Wrightsville Beach, Lumina Center/The Forum on the east side of Military Cutoff, and Mayfaire on the west side of Military Cutoff. All have restaurants. The drawbridge to and from Wrightsville Beach opens on the hour, which adds about 10 minutes to your travel time.

Coffee / Starbucks

The Blockade Runner will have coffee. But if you want other coffee, read on. The closest Starbucks are at Mayfaire (from Military Cutoff, turn left onto International Drive) and Lumina Center (from Eastwood, turn right into the strip mall at the Kangaroo gas station). There are also Port City Java, a local chain in Lumina Station and Café del Mar in Wrightsville Beach (6 North Lumina Ave).

Eating on Your Own

Breakfast

If you are staying at The Blockade Runner, breakfast is included. If you are not, it will cost \$12. The Café del Mar, down the road from the Blockade Runner at 6 North Lumina Ave., and King Neptune (see below) serve breakfast. On the mainland Port City Java in Lumina Station has coffee shop breakfast items and Sweet and Savory and David's Deli (see below) have a full breakfast.

Downtown Wilmington (a 20-25 minute drive from Wrightsville Beach)

Front Street Brewery – 9 North Front Street – www.frontstreetbrewery.com A brew pub. Menu includes a few vegetarian items. Very reasonable prices.

Plus too many others to name, but including The Copper Penny (www.copperpennync.com) and Elija's (www.elijahs.com) which have good food and are reasonable.

Birding

Mason Inlet, at the north end of Wrightsville Beach is usually the best birding spot on Wrightsville Beach. Just drive north from the Blockade Runner. Park at Public Access 2 and walk north.
